## What's Next?

This week we are celebrating a special anniversary. Two years ago in mid-December 2006, we were praying about and struggling over a decision to lead the team headed to Northern Italy. At that point we didn't even know it would be in Verona. Through the people we prayed with and time ourselves in prayer, we felt God leading us to do this work. For the majority of the proceeding year we remained in Ancona, transitioning out of our roles there and helping pass on relationships to Ancona team members. For the last year we have been recruiting for our new team, raising awareness about the work, training ourselves and our team, as well as presenting the new work to our churches and supporters across the US. Through camps, Sunday School meetings, missions team meetings, Sunday worships, small groups, etc... we have shared our heart and God's desire for the people of Verona, Italy to know Him in a way they never have.

We have made many strides, raising 90% of the monthly funding and almost \$15,000 for one time needs. We have added many prayer partners who receive not only our newsletters, but also emails which are published twice monthly. We held a reception, in Tulsa, for anyone wanting to meet our team, during the National Missionary Convention and we had over 90 attendants, not including the 12 adults and kids on our team! Many people's understandings have deepened about God's work in Italy of which we are a part. God has used this time we have been in the states to solidify our relationships with supporting churches and individuals. We have also had the joy of reaching out to youth and challenging them for God's Kingdom. Besides youth, we have also invested in the lives of several college students, raising the bar for their involvement in missions around the world. We have taken a 14 week Perspectives on the World Christian Movement course, that we highly recommend to all believers. We have trained in multiple financial areas to continually improve the level of financial understanding, stewardship and accountability over the monetary responsibility we have under Team Expansion. All these things have moved us closer to the next phase of the departure period.

There are several conditions before we depart for Italy. The first is that we reached over 80% in monthly funding, we reached that. The second is that we raised the one time funds necessary for moving and starting up in a new city, this we have NOT yet done. The third is that someone else on our team would also reach the same two milestones, that is 80+% monthly and most one time funds. In the past

two weeks, April Houk has reached her mark of over 80% monthly funding. She also has the necessary one time funds raised as well. Once we reach our milestone of one time funding we will move into a three month period of departure.

So, what is our need? What is it that YOU can do to move us into that stage? We were trying to raise \$38,521 in one time funds. We have raised \$14,000, which leaves \$24,521. Included in our total goal was \$10,000 towards our team's future facility. Our team will not rent this until the majority is through with language school, approximately a year and a half after we get to the field. We have decided to postpone raising this \$10,000 until closer to the actual need. So, if we postpone \$10,000, we are left with a need of only \$14,521. So, the basic thought is this, once we raise this \$14.521 we will move into a three month departure period. So, if we raise this by the end of December, our departure is at the end of March. If we raise this by the end of January, our departure will be at the end of April. So, we ask your prayers as we ask God to bring in that which through prayer He led us to have determined was wise planning in making this endeavor. Could God bring this amount in within one month? Absolutely! Would you join us in prayer for God's speed for this money? Would you pray if God desires that we continue in the preparation here that He would make that clear? If God is prompting you to give a special gift at this time, please give. Thank you for your prayer and support.

Sometimes we "zone in" so much we fail to see the forest for the trees. Here's how you might see Team Expansion from the 30,000-feet level:

\*\*\* Full-time Team Expansion missionaries went from 302 at the close of 2006 to 311 at the close of 2007 (including full-timers and Quest). Since that time, full-timers alone

have climbed to 307, with full-timers plus Quest now reaching 317. There are 10 additional "V-Core volunteers.

- \*\*\* Countries with active projects went from 44 in 2006 to 47 in 2007.
- \*\*\* "Completed teams" went 43 in 2006 to 47 in 2007.
- \*\*\* Accumulated conversions went from 8706 in 2006 to 9000 in 2007.
- \*\*\* Churches planted went from 198 in 2006 to 205 in 2007.
- \*\*\* Sent 25 summer interns and 6 trip leaders (Coaches) to 10 countries,
- \*\*\* First-time new-field research commenced in 2 new sites in the Middle East and South Asia (continued on page 4)
