Throughout the history of Team Expansion, our purpose has remained the same – to work together in teams in order to establish viable, multiplying communities of believers in some of the least reached places on the earth. Simply, we are church planters.

Team Expansion currently includes more than 300 workers serving in more than 40 countries. To date, we've planted more than 180 churches and baptized more than 10,000 believers around the world.

Can you tell we made a major overhaul of our newsletter? Do you like the new style? Hopefully, it reflects the new direction we are taking in our focus on art & world missions. It is because of the financial and prayer support that you provide that we are able to make a creative difference in the mission work of over 300 Team Expansion missionaries around the world.

Inside you will find our finances, prayer requests, news from our president and a new showcase of the various projects that I am working on for missions worldwide.

We are totally supported by individuals and churches. We do not sell any of the mission related graphics to our missionaries. I know that our missionary's budgets are tight, which make it difficult to afford the plethora of media resources that I will be able to offer to them free of charge.

I know that we have many creative individuals on the field, but time is precious. There were times that I worked 70 hours a week on the field in Italy to get things done. It is a major asset to have an 'onstaff' graphics artist as a support to each of our teams that want it. I want our mission teams to succeed. That's why I feel passionate about creating curriculum, tools, graphics, video, etc....to impact their message and give time back to them.

From the years that many of you supported our ministry and partnered with us, I think you know my heart. My desire is to see the world come to know the lifesaving message of Jesus Christ. To think that I can continue to contribute to that but in a broader scale around the world excites me, and I hope that it excites you too!

We hope that if you support our

ministry you will continue to do so! The only support we have lost in transitioning to a stateside role has been due to those who were supporting the PACE project of Taking Christ to Italy and were supporting us because we were part of that work. One church ran into financial issues and had to stop, but the majority of you are still with us! Thanks. Many of you have supported Angie and I as we follow God in the plan that He has laid out for us.

If you have not supported our mission work in the past, we ask you to consider doing so now. Our monthly budget is lower now that we are based in the United States. It is currently, \$5,549 per month. We have not been able to return to Italy yet to pack our home and close out contracts because our financial plans fell through. We have been able to continue paying out the last several monthly rent payments for our apartment. We hope to have the money raised in order to make our trip in September. We need approximately \$10,000 still to make the trip and pay for the shipping container and travel expenses. Would you consider sending something towards this need, maybe for the first time?

We are looking forward to unveiling the various projects that we are working on, including new kids curriculum, kids cartoon videos, VBS programs, logos, prayer cards and a new Team Expansion website just for kids! We'll introduce you to a few of these projects on the showcase page and then more in future newsletters.

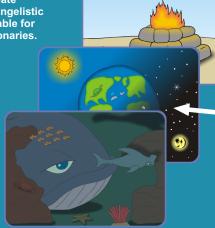
These are prayer cards that I designed for our college aged mission teams going to various places to serve for the summer!
