It's Time to Play the Music...

Since I was a boy, I have loved puppets. I remember playing with them and making all kinds; sock, felt and others. I would perform skits behind a large piece of cardboard for my family. My eyes were glued to the television whenever The Muppets or Sesame Street were on. In Middle School, I joined our church's puppet ministry. Then in High School, I started making my own large puppets, hand sewing them and hot gluing parts on. I even sold some of my creations to various churches and individuals. Then after I graduated, I got the opportunity to lead our church's puppet ministry with my cousin and we expanded and used it all throughout the church and the children's ministry.

For twenty years, this creative aspect of my personality has lay dormant, but I have tapped into it again to expand the future of Jump VBS curriculum. My goal is to create HD downloadable puppet videos that are usable alongside future Jump curriculum.

It takes some time to develop a curriculum. There's research, conceptual art, study, delegation of different tasks, editing, graphic design/development, compiling, publishing and finally promotion. Currently, I am in the very early stages of developing the next Jump VBS material. This new material will be on the life and ministry of Paul the Apostle.

One of the first things I did was draw some conceptual drawings of Paul and how he would look throughout the curriculum. Character design takes time and many sketches, however, Paul came fairly easy for me. When I would close my eyes I had a very specific image of Paul under the water after his shipwreck holding his breath

with a look of alarm. This became the defining image for me and I proceeded to sketch him out.

After that, I started working on a puppet version. To do this, I had to study modern methods of foam

puppet building. When I made my own puppets before, I was using some resources, but mainly making my own style since this was all before the internet and puppet building helps were scarce. For this project, among other things, I have learned the "Henson Stitch" made popular by the late Jim Henson, creator of the Muppets.

So, I still have a ways to go in turning Paul into a puppet, but here's what I have done so far.

Churches are still using, downloading and buying print versions of the first Jump VBS curriculum and

Notes from the Presidei

Each spring, I'm honored to gather together with the heads of 7 other organizations. I generally feel like a lion in a "den of Daniels." We don't have a Development Department, nor do we pay consultants to do mass mail campaigns. (We don't even do mass mail campaigns.) But there is a bit of a silver lining to this dark cloud, depending on how you look at it. For 34 years, for better or worse, we have operated on a very simple paradigm: for every dollar given by every donor, we send 100% of it to the field for which it was given. No smoke and mirrors. No baitand-switch. 100%. Then we ask each worker or family to make an offering of \$100 per month for everything we do internationally. So when you donate funds toward the work of your favorite Team Expansion missionary, literally all of it goes toward that missionary's work. Then, if he or she is at the top of his or her game, a small gift of \$100 goes back to the Home Office to cover all the services offered on behalf of the organization as a whole. (Likewise, each worker at the Home Office, save one receptionist, raises support just like field-based missionaries. God be praised for those who make their work possible, by the way, because they are, in turn, making possible a global work force.) I'll admit: It's not as much fun to operate this way. (In fact, building a training campus is like pulling teeth! :-)) But we hope it pleases donors. We hope it brings a focus on our fields of service. And most of all, we hope it helps get the job done for God's glory. Thank you for your support of Team Expansion!
